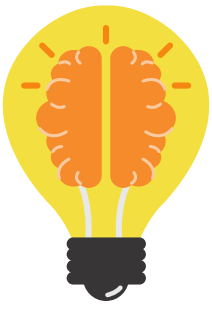


Σ TIPS FOR SUCCESS IN MATH COURSES

Create a study group too!

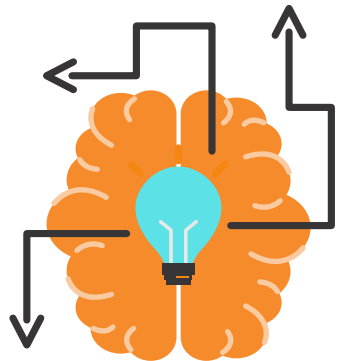


STEP THREE
